

Art Contest – Rules and Regulations

I. Entries

A. Any pieces entered into the Art Contest may only be within the following mediums:

1. Drawing (crayon, colored pencil, marker, oil pastel)
2. Painting (brush, oil, acrylic, watercolor)
3. Sculpture (metal, clay, abstract – using different items to create the sculpture)
4. Cloth (quilt, pillow, blanket, plush figure, NO COSTUMES OR COSPLAY)
5. Computerized entries; anything drawn, painted, or configured by a computer program.

B. The dimensions of any work must be confined within 3 feet wide by 3 feet tall by 3 feet deep (one cubic square).

C. All submitted works must be PG or under. Please remember: no blood, no partial or full nudity, no yaoi or yuri, no suggestive acts. If you have any questions regarding this, please do not hesitate to contact Jennifer Falk (Vendor/Artist Department Head).

D. Any direct plagiarism will forfeit your work in the contest. Please keep all pieces original and of your own creativity.

E. Only three (3) entries may be entered into the Art Contest – this also includes pieces for the Silent Auction. You may only have three pieces showed, and must choose your entries for the silent auction and contest out of those three pieces.

F. At this moment in time, the Department Head is in contact with the Union Art Gallery to use the space for the silent auction and art contest. More details will follow as to how pieces will be displayed.

G. All entries will be judged by three art student volunteers from UWM.

II. Entrants

A. All entrants must be age 13 and up.

B. Any entrant under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardian with them at the time of submission.

C. Placement of all pieces in the art contest is Friday, March 12, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. Failure to submit your piece in this time frame will disqualify you from both the silent auction and the art contest.

D. Submission deadline is February 1, 2010. Since there will be a limited number of spaces available, please register early!

III. Pick-up

A. Next to each piece will be a small tag labeling the creator of the artwork, the name of the artwork, and whether the artwork is entered into the silent auction, art contest, or both.

B. If an artist has placed their artwork in the silent auction as well as the art contest and it was not bid upon, please come during pick-up on Sunday to retrieve your work. Pick-up is from 12:00 to 1:00 pm on Sunday.

When you contract space and submit your paperwork, you acknowledge that by signing the contract that you agree to the terms contained in it. That includes these terms. Please, read the contract and ask questions regarding anything you don't understand. If you fail to read this contract prior to signing, you risk being declared in breach of contract. Breaking these rules may result in the loss of placing your artwork in both the Art Silent Auction and the Art Contest.

Tags will be made for each piece of artwork submitted, and will be ready for when the artist arrives with their artwork. However, please note in what kind of format your artwork must be shown (hanging, pedestal, floor, etc.).

Please also note: there is a limit of three (3) pieces of artwork limited to each artist. Either three for the silent auction, three for the art contest, or a combination of both (two for the silent auction and one for the art contest, etc.). However, no more than three entries may be submitted overall.
